

Notice of Primary Pamlico County, NC

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to G.S. 163-33(8); the registration books will close on Friday, April 9, 2009, at 5:00pm for the Primary to be held on May 4, 2010 in the County of Pamlico, North Carolina.

Absentee ballots by mail are available for all Pamlico County registered voters. Requests for absentee ballots must be made in writing and received in the Pamlico County Board of Elections office no later than 5:00pm on April 27, 2010.

One-Stop Voting will be available for all registered voters of Pamlico County and will be held at the Pamlico County Courthouse, 202 Main Street, Bayboro, NC. Same Day Registration is available at the One-Stop Voting location for all residents of Pamlico County. Residents registering at One-Stop Voting must provide proof of residency by presenting one of the following valid documents that show the persons name and current residence address: a North Carolina drivers license, a photo identification from a government agency or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows the current name and residential address of the resident. One-Stop Voting will begin April 15, 2010 and will end May 1, 2010 at 1:00pm. One-Stop Voting hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00am through 5:00pm, and Saturday, May 1, 2010 from 8:00am through 1:00pm.

The absentee review board meetings will be held at 2:00pm at the office of the Pamlico County Board of Elections, located at 202 Main Street, Bayboro, NC, on April 13, 2010, April 20, 2010, April 27, 2010 and May 4, 2010. The Board will meet at 2:00pm on Election Day at the office of the Pamlico County Board of Elections to conduct the absentee tally. Results will be released at 7:30pm, when the polls closed.

Canvass will be held at 11:00am May 11, 2010 at the office of the Pamlico County Board of Elections.
